So mark your calendars now and we hope to see you at one of the Christmas Eve services and on New Year's Eve!




Please note change in Food Pantry hours: 1st & 3rd Tuesday 10:30-2:00

Greetings from the Loaves and Fishes food pantry. A great big THANK YOU to all who continue to support the pantry with food and money donations. We couldn't do it without you. Also thanks to my regular volunteers who shop for me and make regular pickups of donated food and those who help me out on pantry days to help me restock and keep me company!!!

The number of families has continued to grow mainly by word of mouth within the Hispanic community. We're regularly feeding 20-25 families. We've been supporting some families with some extra supplies as we can. We have a newborn only a couple weeks old we support and we continue to support the triplets as best we can.

Unfortunately our success doesn't come without a cost. We have so much food going out, we're unable to fund the food we need to buy. We are only "buying" necessary food like cooking oil, flour, sugar, salt, rice, dry black and dry kidney beans, pasta, pasta sauce, canned fruit, ketchup, mustard, mayonnaise and cereal. Other food will be provided only as donated.


We can use any donation of food and could really use food gift cards.
